primer:

Primer 112 can be processed with hardener 50 W. Hardener quantity must be adjusted tot he respective object temperature (see table). At temperatures below + 5°C, accelerator B101 can additionally be added must be added (~ 0.5 % at 0 °C up to 3 % at –30 °C) with retention of 6 PBV hardener powder.

After mixing in the hardener powder, Plastifloor® 112 is being equally and thinly dispersed with a roller or rubber squeegee (300-600 g/m²). Consumption must be adjusted individually. On extremely absorbent substrates, prime twice in order to achieve a thin but closed film that bonds the broadcasting material. We recommend slightly broadcasting the primer with quartz sand (size 0.7-1.2 mm). If only thin sealers are to be applied, we recommend using quartz sand in size 0.4 - 0.8 mm. This work step ensures an absolutely solid bond between primer and the following coating.

Consumption ~ 300-600 g/m² per work step

Further coating layers with Plastifloor must only be applied after the previous layers have completely cured.
